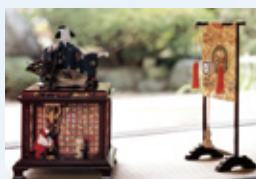

Located between Tokyo and Osaka, Aichi-Nagoya is one of the nation's largest transportation hubs with substantial expressway and railway networks, Chubu Centrair International Airport, and ports suitable for large cruise ships. Downtown Nagoya can be reached in about 30 minutes by train from Chubu Centrair International Airport and about 100 minutes from Tokyo and 50 minutes from Osaka by bullet train.

Aichi-Nagoya has many MICE venues such as the Nagoya Congress Center and Portmesse Nagoya, which boast numerous MICE events; and the Aichi Sky Expo, which opened in 2019 and is the first exhibition center directly connected to the international airport in Japan.

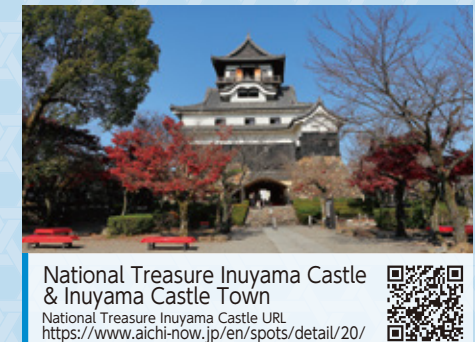

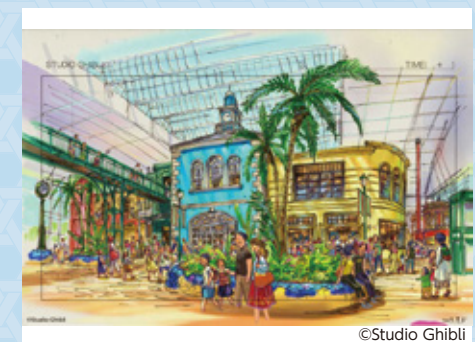

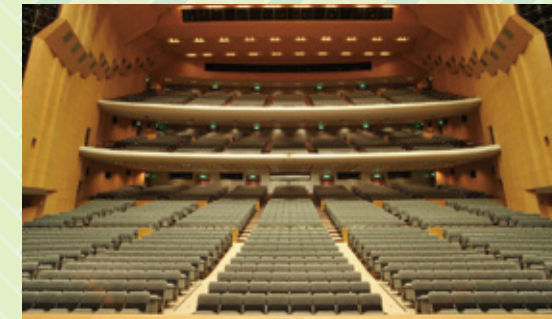

Nagoya Congress Center

The Century Hall, with a capacity of approximately 3,000 seats, a multi-purpose event hall, Shirotori Hall, a reception hall, exhibition rooms, and large, medium, and small conference rooms can be used for a variety of events, including international conferences, ceremonies, exhibitions, and concerts.

Nagoya International Exhibition Hall (Portmesse Nagoya)

The exhibition facility is approximately 40,000 m², consisting of the new Exhibition Hall 1 (opening in October 2022), Exhibition Hall 2, and Exhibition Hall 3, which can accommodate a variety of events. In addition to these facilities, the building is also equipped to cater to conferences, seminars and ceremonies.

Aichi International Exhibition Center (Aichi Sky Expo)

Aichi Sky Expo is the only permanent bonded exhibition center and the first exhibition center directly connected to the international airport in Japan. Its 60,000 m² exhibition space is one of the largest in Japan.

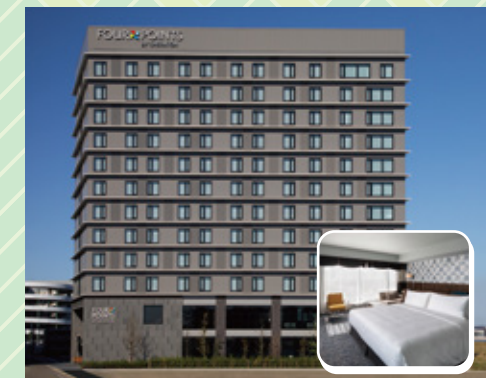

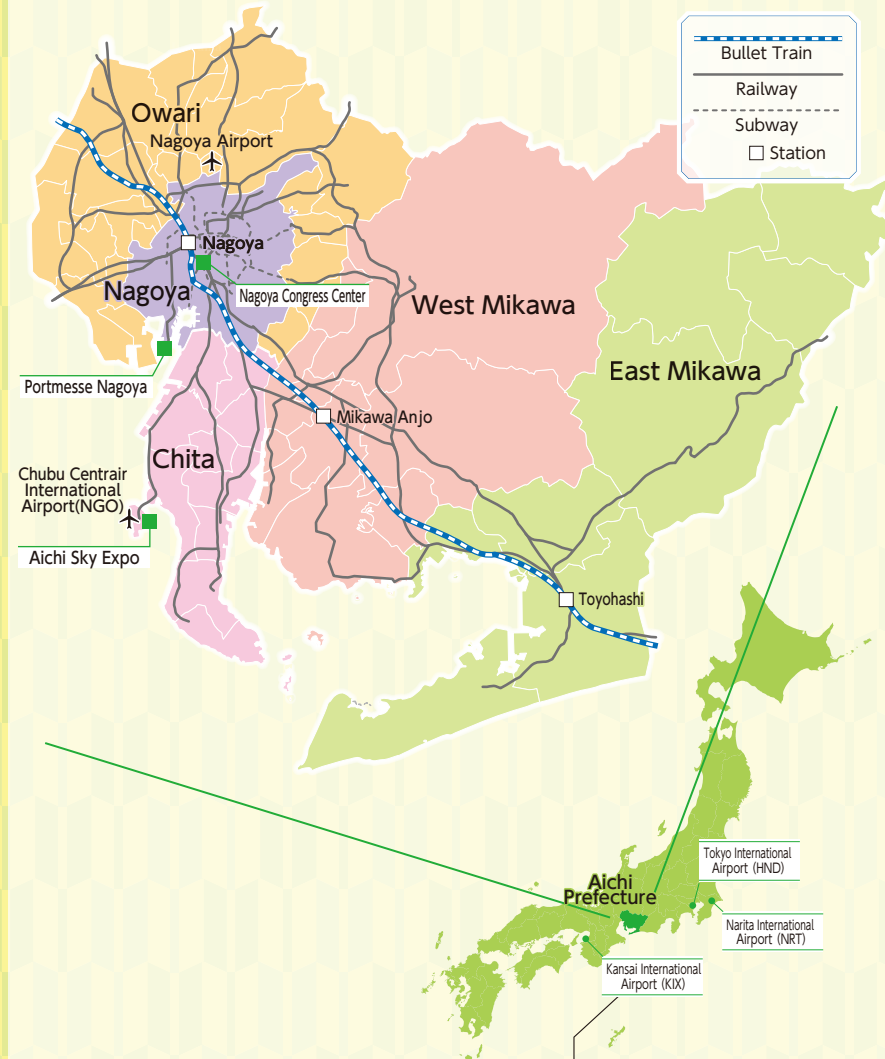
Location & Access

Location & Access

As the heart of Japan, Aichi-Nagoya possesses Chubu Centrair International Airport which serves as a gateway that connects Aichi-Nagoya to cities in Japan and abroad.

Expressways and bullet trains also make Aichi-Nagoya a transportation gateway for easy travel to other destinations in Japan.

In the near future, the SCMAGLEV high-speed passenger train line will be in operation to allow for even faster travel between Tokyo and Nagoya within 40 min.
